GUIDELINES TO STARTING A TEEN REPUBLICAN CLUB/CHAPTER

- Step #1:** Identify a minimum of five (5) teenagers (ages 13-19) who are interested in organizing a Teen Republican Club.
- Step #2:** Contact the local County Republican Party Chairman to assist finding an advisor (*Recommended that students find a teacher sponsor before going to the school principal to ask to organize a TRS chapter in their school as a club*).
- Step #3:** Identify an advisor (recommended: 21 years of age or older). There should be no meetings without the presence of an adult – minimum of 21 years of age.
- Step #4:** Set the time and the place to have an “organizing meeting” to approve a constitution (bylaws) and elect officers.
- Step #5:** Publicize your “organizing meeting” in your local newspaper, county GOP newsletter, etc. to encourage teens to attend said meeting.
- Step #6:** Notify the State TRS Chairman of the time and place for the “organizing meeting”.
- Step #7:** Request “Organizing TRS Paperwork Packet” from the State Organization.
- Step #8:** Meet to approve constitution (bylaws) and elect officers.
- Step #9:** Complete organizing paperwork and send to the State Organization (by the postal service or digitally).
- Step #10:** The GATRS Executive Board will review completed paperwork and present you with your charter when your request is reviewed and approved.
